

The only reason for refusal is that proposed excavation works shall effect archeological remains. This is not the case in view that the existing development over the site is covered by PA 2415/02.

Only 60cm of excavation depth shall be carried out to remove inert material debris which had been dumped over the site 15 years ago.

The proposed garage internal height of 2.6m may be further lowered to the allowable 2.4m in order to minimize excavation works.

It is solicited that the EPRT carry over an on site inspection to verify the above accordingly.
