**Location:** *D.D.E. Attard Ltd. u d-dintorni, Triq Valletta, Luqa (as stated in ERA letter dated 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2019)*

On behalf of our client, Mr Joseph Attard of Ċensina House, Dejma Road, Fgura, ID number 177575m, ID number 454377m, we have been instructed to lodge an appeal against the *Stop and Conformance Order* letter dated 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2019 having case number IF0315/19 and ERA reference number OWK 0019/19, hereinafter termed *the Order*. The Order refers to the site area marked in red in the site plan attached with the notification letter, hereinafter termed *the Site*.

The Order has closed down the Site and ordered its clearance of all waste materials present on site without necessary permits.

However we would like to note that the Site is actually composed of 4 different and separate areas owned and operated by different entities who are wholly separate and distinct.

- Approximately two thirds of the Site, which is located at the North of the Site, is owned by Malta Industrial Parks
- The Site includes a public road
- Area owned and operated by DDE Attard Ltd.
- Area owned and operated by Metalco Ltd.

Accordingly the Stop and Conformance Order is invalid as it enforces conditions on an entity as a result of activities carried out by other separate and distinct entities on separate and distinct sites.
